I would welcome a broader discussion NFF thinking on engagement with the region, how we can assist and to also provide some suggestions. With s 33(a)(iii) keen to engage with Australia (and countries they see as still sharing the aim of free and open trade) I am wondering whether a specific NFF and s 33(a)(iii) connection – separate to s 33(a)(iii) may be worth thinking about. What does that mean practically because clearly it isn't possible to be travelling to LATAM all the time – it could be being part of discussions at forums like the FAO, WTO and COP – event where NFF is more likely to have a presence. s 33(a)(iii)

Realistically there is little likelihood that we will be able to materially contribute to, or even attend, anything as soon as April. We will obviously pretty focused on the election in the coming months. That said, as I mentioned when we spoke last year don't really have an issue if <sup>s 33(a)(iii)</sup> want to just run with it and try and organise something.

What I think is the more realistic options is just a side engagement COP30 with any <sup>s 33(a)(iii)</sup> members in attendance. Worst case we just have a bi lateral engagement between us and <sup>s 33(a)(iii)</sup> similar to what we did at COP29. **s 33(a)(iii)**
