\$1.03 billion

Long-term sustainable funding to support a strong biosecurity system that is critical to keeping Australia's economy, our agriculture, fisheries and forestry industries and unique environment healthy and prosperous and keeping our regional and remote communities strong.



Other measures include:



\$40.6 million

For continued partnerships with Indigenous Rangers to provide vital early detection and surveillance for biosecurity threats along Australia's vast northern coastline.



\$20 million

To progress implementation of the National Soil Action Plan and establish a soil monitoring program through partnerships with states and territories.



\$302.1 million

To invest in climate-smart, sustainable practices that build climate resilience, increase market access and agricultural growth while supporting sustainability outcomes.



\$5 million

To develop a renewed Australian Animal Welfare Strategy to cement a national approach to animal welfare and signal that animal welfare is a priority for Australia.



\$5.6 million

For an independent panel to undertake an assessment and broad-ranging consultation to inform the government's commitment to phase out live sheep exports by sea.



\$38.3 million

To support policy and program development to assist the agriculture, fisheries and forestry sectors to adapt to climate change, improve their economic resilience and ensure they can continue to prosper and grow.
