



Offshore Treatment Providers European Union Member States

As at 2 June 2023

The use of methyl bromide in the European Union (EU) was banned on 18 March 2010 for most purposes, including quarantine and pre-shipment fumigations.

In view of this ban, certificates for methyl bromide fumigations performed by EU countries (as listed below) post 18 March 2010 will **not be accepted**.

Treatment certificates are not accepted from treatment providers as of the date they are listed as ‘unacceptable’ or ‘under investigation’. There is no allowance for goods in transit.
