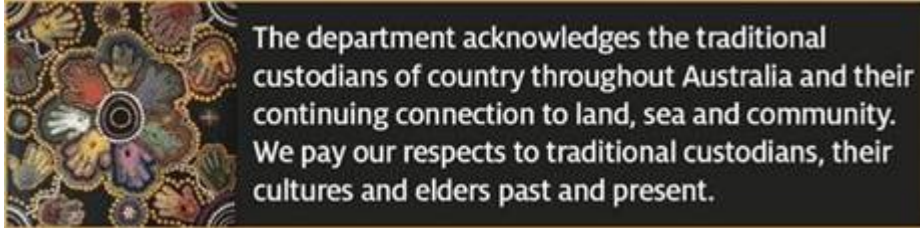

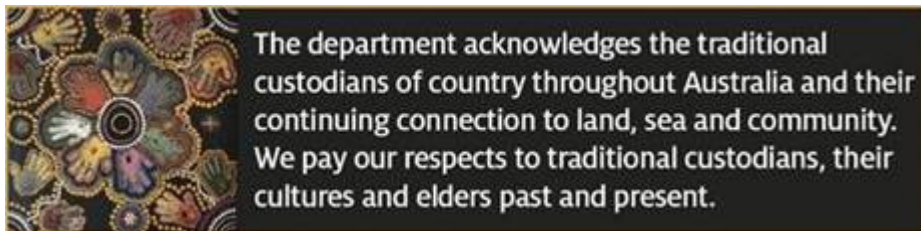

Having said all this, I am not sure a standard permit will resolve s. 33(a)(iii) issues with Australia's import requirement for dairy for animal feed.

s. 47(1)(b) often contacts the department to receive an approval (which we call an IVA – in vivo approval) to downgrade NZ dairy already imported for human consumption to animal feed.

s. 47(1)(b) has advised that they prefer to get an IVA as an import permit for animal feed requires much more documentation than importing for human consumption.

They prefer to then downgrade imported dairy into animal feed by coming to the department.

Ultimately, a standard permit for NZ dairy may not achieve the efficiency and streamlining of the process they are seeking.

This was developed and enacted well before our time in this work area. Subsequently, it has been operationalised and managed through ABIB (s. 22(1)(a)(ii) team, now s. 22(1)(a)(ii)).

We are therefore not in a position to discuss the dairy downgrade policy at the proposed meeting, s. 33(a)(iii)

You may like to call on s. 22(1)(a)(ii) or s. 22(1)(a)(ii) to explain the dairy downgrade policy at that time?

We are happy to attend a presentation but again not discuss next steps (until those are worked out within BAD according to priorities and resources). I attach a slide with preliminary FAS thinking on BAD priorities delivered by s. 22(1)(a)(ii) the other day.

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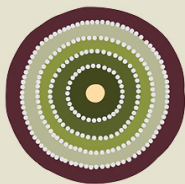

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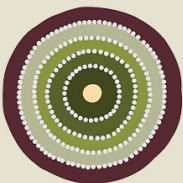

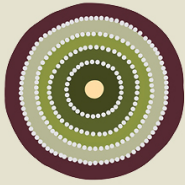
