\* The following state/territory industry FMD accounts and holdings have been aggregated with the respective New South Wales industry FMD accounts and holdings where there are less than 20 accounts for privacy reasons:

- Victoria - Sugar, Pig and Other
- Queensland - Other
- South Australia - Other
- Western Australia - Sugar, Pig and Other
- Tasmania - Grain, Pig and Other
- Australian Capital Territory and Northern Territory – horticulture, crops, grain, grain-sheep/beef, sheep-beef and sheep

These monthly FMD statistics are derived from data provided by Authorised Deposit-taking Institutions (ADIs) (such as banks and credit unions). These statistics may, due to the complex nature of FMDs, include a level of discrepancy, leading to a minor overstatement or understatement of the actual holdings eligible for the FMD taxation concessions.
