

#### Spotlight exhibitor investment

The exhibitor package is \$3,000 (GST inclusive) and includes:

- One trade stand site in the foyer of the National Convention Centre, allocated according to your preference and the order of bookings received.
- An exhibition booth approximately 3.3 metres wide, with Velcro-compatible walls, fascia panel with your organisation's name in vinyl lettering and two 300-watt gooseneck lights. Note: you are welcome to contact SBX (System Built Exhibitions) to obtain unique wall panels, power outlets and/or flooring, at your expense.
- One table with tablecloth and two chairs.
- One complimentary exhibitor registration (valued at \$1,650 (GST inclusive)) which includes day catering, a ticket to the conference dinner and access to all conference sessions.



- Two complimentary exhibitor aide registrations (combined value of more than \$3,000 (GST inclusive)) which include day catering and access to conference sessions where space permits. Note: the conference dinner is not included in the exhibitor aide registration, but a ticket can be purchased separately.
