

### **Broad land use in the Toowoomba region**




### Value of production and exports at record highs

# Darling Downs - Maranoa land values increasing




Average farm capital value (in real terms)

### Australian Government Global economic growth prospects have been Department of Agriculture, downgraded




# Global food prices are now at decade highs, fertiliser even higher








## Favourable growing conditions likely for the winter season


BOM rainfall 3 month outlook. August to October 2022.




# Dry conditions in major export competitors limit world wheat supply






# Russia's invasion of Ukraine and mounting supply concerns are driving grain price volatility




# High wheat prices to persist reflecting tight global supply





#### Coarse grain prices to remain elevated in 2022–23






#### Horticulture sector boosted by high prices





#### A record year for Australian cotton lint production






# Value of beef production to fall slightly due to lower cattle prices


### Sheepmeat prices to fall but remain high in 2022–23

  - Outbreak in Northern Queensland
  - Outbreak in Victoria
- Largest costs due to loss of access to FMD sensitive markets
