

# Pre-arrival report for vessels 7 metres or longer travelling from certain areas in Torres Strait

Form approved under the Biosecurity Act 2015

### Section A: General information

### Purpose of this form

For the person in charge of a vessel that is 7 metres or longer to report a voyage that will arrive in Australian territory from either the Torres Strait Protected Zone (TSPZ) or the Torres Strait Permanent Biosecurity Monitoring Zone (TSPBMZ).

Penalties apply for:

- failing to provide a report to a biosecurity official or customs officer
- providing false or misleading information.

Vessels transiting directly through the shipping channels and not stopping in Torres Strait are exempt from reporting requirements.

The Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry collects your 'protected information' including personal information in relation to this document under the Biosecurity Act for the purposes of conducting biosecurity risk assessments on the movement of goods from the Torres Strait Protected Zone to Torres Strait Permanent Biosecurity Monitoring Zone, or from either of these zones to Australian territory, and related purposes. If you fail to provide the relevant personal information requested in this document, the department will be unable to complete a full biosecurity risk assessment and/or contact you should future biosecurity risks emerge. Information collected by the department will only be used or disclosed as authorised under the Biosecurity Act.

The department may disclose your personal information to other Australian agencies, including the Department of Home Affairs and Australian Border Force. It will not usually be disclosed overseas. In every case, it will only be disclosed if authorised by the Biosecurity Act.
