

Request permission to bring goods to an alternative biosecurity entry point under the *Biosecurity Act 2015*

Section A: General information

Purpose of this form

For the person in charge of a conveyance (vessel operator, vessel master or shipping agent) to apply for permission to bring goods to an alternative biosecurity entry point in Australian territory in accordance with the requirements under section 148(1) of the *Biosecurity Act 2015*.

- vessels arriving at first points of entry or non-first points of entry.
- approved arrangement sites.

treatment certification (if applicable)

Biosecurity Management Plan (required for large or complex machinery or equipment)

photographic evidence demonstrating:

- the condition of the goods
- how the goods were shipped
- the area onshore where you propose to unload the goods.

Deadline for applications

Submit completed applications by email at least 10 working days before arrival in Australian territory (where possible).

Applications are assessed on merit and may not be approved.

Information collected by the department will only be used or disclosed as authorised under the Biosecurity Act.

By completing and submitting this form you consent to the collection and disclosure of all personal information contained in this form. You must have obtained the express, current, specific and informed consent of all other persons whose personal information or commercially sensitive information you have included in this form, to disclose the information to the department.

The department may disclose the personal information included in this form to other Australian agencies, including the Department of Home Affairs, Australian Border Force, the Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Communications and persons or organisations where necessary for these purposes. This personal information will not usually be disclosed overseas. In every case it will only be disclosed if authorised by the Biosecurity Act.
