A false, misleading or incomplete disclosure of material interests constitutes a breach of a condition of your accreditation and may result in your accreditation being suspended or revoked under Chapter 9 of the *Export Control (Animals) Rules 2021.*

## Section I: Privacy notice

Your personal information may also be disclosed to relevant employees within your organisation for the purpose of approving your accreditation and to maintain the currency of your personal information for the purpose of the accreditation. Your personal information will be used and stored in accordance with the Australian Privacy Principles.

By completing and submitting this form you consent to the collection, use and disclosure of all personal information, including sensitive information, in this form to the relevant authorities in the importing country.

The department has not taken steps to ensure that the relevant authorities in the importing country do not breach the Australian Privacy Principles. This means that:
