

## Application for plant export accreditation of farms

Form approved under section 377 of the Export Control Act 2020.

#### Section A: General information

#### Purpose of this form

For managers of farms to apply for accreditation to export the following to protocol markets

- avocados
- bananas
- capsicums
- carrots
- cucurbits (cucumber, honeydew melon, pumpkin, rockmelon, watermelon, scallopini, zucchini)
- kiwifruit
- lychees
- persimmons
- potatoes
- strawberries
- sweetcorn.

For information about applying for accreditation to export other commodities, contact the relevant peak industry body listed in the Industry advice notice issued before the export season begins.

#### Before applying

Understand your obligations under:

- Section 377 in Chapter 11 Part 1 of the Export Control Act 2020
- Guideline: Management of horticulture export accredited properties
- Guideline: Audit of horticulture export accredited properties.

Ensure the commodity you need accreditation for is listed in Reference: Table of plant export protocol markets.

Ensure that the applicant's name, signature, and contact details belong to the Manager of the Property.

#### To complete this form

## Your application must include

A map of the farm which should be electronic and must be accurate showing the below.

- · farm's boundaries including main road names
- surrounding areas and major infrastructure (e.g. packhouse, dam, or dwellings)
- borders of each farm block within the farm (if applying for accreditation of individual block)
- any other required information referenced in the workplan and/or industry advice notice

All individual blocks, roads and packhouses, if applicable, must be labelled and identified on the map.

## Section F: Privacy notice

'Personal information' is defined in the *Privacy Act 1998* and includes information or an opinion about an identified, or reasonably identifiable, individual.
