Mortality details</p>	<p>For each mortality record, document the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tag type and number • Deck number • Pen ID • Species • Livestock class • Number of head (if sheep or goats) • Any approved management plan that the animal(s) were prepared under • Was the animal euthanised or found dead • Was a post-mortem conducted? If no, why was a post-mortem not conducted? • Diagnosis (or presumptive diagnosis) • Other factors that may have led to mortality • Daily and cumulative number of livestock mortalities - per species and class • Voyage mortality rate per species (% to date) 	<p>Recorded per animal / tag number per day</p>

Births and abortions</p>	<p>For any birth or abortion, record the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tag type and number (of dam) • Deck number (of dam) • Pen ID (of dam) • Species (of dam) • Livestock class (of dam) • Any approved management plan that the dam was prepared under • If birth, what was the outcome for young • If abortion, what was the estimated age of young at time of abortion (weeks or months) 	<p>Recorded per animal / tag number per day</p>
<p>18. General comments</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • General comments (e.g. exceptions, further comments on deck or any other conditions) 	<p>Once per day (as required)</p>
