



## Guide to end-of-voyage report data fields under ASEL 3.0

This document is intended to provide guidance only and is not the Australian Standards for the Export of Livestock (ASEL) 3.0 approved form.

Reporting Section	Data Fields
1. Voyage details	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>LNC number</li> <li>Exporter name (as per export licence)</li> <li>Vessel name</li> <li>Were daily reports required to be submitted to the Australian Government for this consignment?</li> </ul>
2. On-board personnel	<p>Only collect the following if daily reports are not required to be submitted to the Australian Government:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Is there an Australian Government Accredited Veterinarian (AAV) on-board for the consignment?</li> <li>Names and accreditation numbers of all AAVs on-board (for the consignment)</li> <li>Names of all accredited stockpersons on-board (for the consignment)</li> <li>Names of all competent stock handlers on-board (for the consignment)</li> </ul>
3. Consignment loading details	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Departure port</li> <li>Date and time loading commenced (local &amp; UTC time zones)</li> <li>Date and time loading completed (local &amp; UTC time zones)</li> <li>Date and time of vessel departure (local &amp; UTC time zones)</li> </ul> <p>Only collect the following if daily reports are not required to be submitted to the Australian Government:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Number of animals loaded by species and class</li> </ul>
4. Consignment discharge details	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Discharge port name(s)</li> <li>Date and time of vessel arrival (by port if more than one) (local &amp; UTC time zones)</li> <li>Date and time first animal unloaded (by port if more than one) (local &amp; UTC time zones)</li> <li>Date and time last animal unloaded (by port if more than one) (local &amp; UTC time zones)</li> <li>Total number of animals unloaded at each port by class and species (by port if more than one)</li> <li>Actual voyage length (days)</li> </ul>
5. Feed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Amount and type of feed remaining on-board at completion of the voyage (for the consignment)</li> <li>Availability and accessibility of feed</li> <li>Trough space</li> <li>Other feed issues</li> </ul> <p>Only collect the following if daily reports are not required to be submitted to the Australian Government:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Feed loading details (for the consignment): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Amount and type of suitable feed remaining on-board (ROB) from a previous voyage (if applicable)</li> <li>Amount and type of feed loaded by port, for the consignment</li> <li>Total feed on-board for the consignment – by type of feed</li> </ul> </li> <li>Were all livestock provided with sufficient feed to meet ASEL minimum daily feed requirements for the duration of the voyage? If no, provide details</li> <li>Feed quality</li> </ul>
6. Water	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Average voyage water consumption (L/hd/day)</li> <li>Other water issues</li> </ul>

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	<p>Only collect the following if daily reports are not required to be submitted to the Australian Government:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Water quality and any supply issues</li> </ul>
7. Environmental conditions	<p>Only collect the following if daily reports are not required to be submitted to the Australian Government:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Were there any environmental conditions that were of concern? If yes, provide detail</li> <li>• Were there any deck conditions of concern? If yes, provide detail</li> <li>• Were there any ventilation issues? If yes, provide detail</li> </ul>
8. Bedding	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Amount of bedding that was on-board (for the consignment)</li> <li>• Amount of bedding remaining on-board at the completion of the voyage (for the consignment)</li> <li>• Was bedding used for the consignment? If yes, what type of bedding and what were the reasons for use?</li> </ul>
9. Health report for all stock (including hospital pens)	<p>Only collect the following if daily reports are not required to be submitted to the Australian Government:</p> <p>For each health record, document the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Voyage day number</li> <li>• Tag type and number</li> <li>• Deck number</li> <li>• Pen ID</li> <li>• Species</li> <li>• Livestock class</li> <li>• Number of head (if sheep or goats)</li> <li>• Any approved management plans that the animal(s) were prepared under</li> <li>• Health condition or injury</li> <li>• Medications and/or treatments administered</li> <li>• Other actions taken</li> </ul>
10. Mortality details	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Total number of livestock mortalities - by species and class</li> <li>• Voyage mortality rate (%) - by species</li> <li>• Average daily mortality rate (%) - by species</li> </ul> <p>Only collect the following if daily reports are not required to be submitted to the Australian Government</p> <p>For each mortality record, document the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Voyage day number</li> <li>• Tag type and number</li> <li>• Deck number</li> <li>• Pen ID</li> <li>• Species</li> <li>• Livestock class</li> <li>• Number of head (if sheep or goats)</li> <li>• Any approved management plans that the animal(s) were prepared under</li> <li>• Was the animal euthanised or found dead</li> <li>• Was a post-mortem conducted? If no, why was a post-mortem not conducted?</li> <li>• Diagnosis (or presumptive diagnosis)</li> <li>• Other factors that may have led to mortality</li> </ul>
11. Births and abortions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Total number of births during the voyage</li> <li>• Total number of abortions during the voyage</li> </ul> <p>Only collect the following if daily reports are not required to be submitted to the Australian Government</p> <p>For any birth or abortion, record the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Voyage day number</li> <li>• Tag type and number (of dam)</li> </ul>

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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Deck number (of dam)</li> <li>• Pen ID (of dam)</li> <li>• Species (of dam)</li> <li>• Livestock class (of dam)</li> <li>• Any approved management plans that the dam was prepared under</li> <li>• If birth, what was the outcome for young</li> <li>• If abortion, what was the estimated age of young at time of abortion (weeks or months)</li> </ul>
12. Relationships between on-board personnel	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Did any aspect of the relationships between the master, crew, AAV(s), accredited stockperson(s), independent observer or competent stock handler(s) impact on the management of animal health and welfare? If yes, provide details</li> </ul>
13. Discharge operation comments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Do you have any concerns with the discharge? If yes, provide details</li> </ul>
14. Information about any unexpected animal health or welfare issues	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Was there any unexpected health or welfare issues? If yes, provide details</li> <li>• Any photos and videos of animal health and welfare concerns can be submitted to the department at <a href="mailto:livestockexp@awe.gov.au">livestockexp@awe.gov.au</a></li> </ul>
15. Heavy cattle / buffalo	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Were any cattle/buffalo under an approved heavy management plan?</li> <li>• Was the pen space allowance suitable to allow animals to rest (note if stock required moving to have more space)? If no, provide details</li> <li>• Were there any issues with dominant or aggressive animals? If yes, provide details</li> <li>• Were there any issues with bedding or pad management (including insufficient bedding)? If yes, provide details</li> <li>• Were there any other health or welfare issues identified? If yes, provide details</li> </ul>
