



**NOTICE OF DECISION TO GRANT A PERMIT UNDER THE *HAZARDOUS WASTE
(REGULATION OF EXPORTS AND IMPORTS) ACT 1989***

Pursuant to section 33 of the *Hazardous Waste (Regulation of Exports and Imports) Act 1989*, notice is given that Waigani import permit AUH17-021 was granted to Total Waste Management Ltd, PO Box 473, Waigani, National Capital District 131, Papua New Guinea, Telephone: +675 320 3242, Facsimile: + 675 320 2688.

The particulars of the permit are as follows:

- (a) the type of waste to be imported is non-halogenated organic solvent waste (Basel Code A3140);
- (b) the maximum quantity of the waste that may be imported is 100,000 litres;
- (c) the waste is to be imported by sea and then by road and/or sea to the disposal/recovery facilities;
- (d) the waste may only be imported during the permit period;
- (e) the waste is to be imported to Brisbane, Australia;
- (f) the waste will be dealt with by the following disposal/recovery operations:
 - i. D9 – physico chemical treatment not specified elsewhere in Annex IV to the Basel Convention, which results in final compounds or mixtures which are discarded by means of any of the operation (e.g., evaporation, drying, calcination, neutralisation, precipitation, etc.) in Annex IV, Section A, to the Basel Convention; followed by,
 - ii. D5 – specifically engineered landfill, (e.g., placement in to lined discrete cells which are capped and isolated from one another and the environment, etc.);
 - iii. R13 – accumulation of material intended for any operation in Annex IV, Section B, to the Basel Convention; followed by,
 - iv. R1 – Use as a fuel (other than in direct incineration) or other means to generate energy.
- (g) the waste is to undergo the disposal/recovery operations at the following facilities:
 - i. D9/R13 - at Cleanaway Operations Ltd T/A Nationwide Oil Pty Ltd, 26-32 Potassium Street, Narangba, Queensland;
 - ii. D5 - at Cleanaway Operations Ltd, Ipswich landfill, Chum Street and 20 Rhondda Road, New Chum, Queensland; and,
 - iii. R1 - at Geocycle Gladstone, Cement Australia (Queensland) Pty Ltd, Part A and Part B Fishermans Landing Road, Gladstone.

The permit period is from 11 September 2017 to 10 September 2018. All transboundary movements must be completed by the permit expiry date.

The permit includes and is subject to conditions.
