Additional Information: Goods that become subject to quarantine continue to be subject to quarantine until released from quarantine. Goods subject to quarantine include goods ordered into quarantine (section 18(2) (f)). The importer and/or owner of animals, plants or good subject to quarantine are liable to pay any expenses connected with the examination, transportation, detention, maintenance, treatment, movement, removal, disposal or destruction of the animals, plants or goods (section 64). In addition the Master, owner and/or agent of any vessel ordered into quarantine, or ordered to be treated are liable to pay the cost of piloting or towing the vessel, removing things from the vessel and treating the vessel and things on the vessel or removed from it (section 59A). If at the end of a period for which any goods have been detained, a Director of Quarantine is of the opinion that the goods cannot be released without an unacceptable high level of quarantine risk, he or she may direct that the goods be detained in such a manner and for such further period as stated in the direction (section 48). A person is guilty of a criminal offence if he or she contravenes a quarantine officer's direction under section 48 (section 48(5)). If goods are moved or otherwise interfered with in contravention of the Quarantine Act 1908 they may be seized and forfeited to the Commonwealth (section 68). The Commonwealth does not accept liability for damage which may occur as a result of any necessary treatment. If the person in charge of goods has been notified that treatment may damage the goods, and the person in charge does not, before the end of 30 days after the day on which the person in charge receives the notice, give written notice to a Director of Quarantine stating that they agree to the treatment, the goods may be forfeited to the Commonwealth (section 48AA(5)). A cost recovery charge that is due and payable to the Commonwealth under the Biosecurity Act 2015 may be recovered as a debt due to the Commonwealth by action in a relevant court (section 59G).
