- \$420M allocated to drought resilience initiatives through the FDF to date
- Multiple programs underway with 5 NEW programs announced in March 2022.



BETTER CLIMATE INFORMATION

- 2 digital tools live and being progressively enhanced to help farmers and regions understand their climate risks and resilience.
- 450 + engagement events held to facilitate co-design of the tools across 8 pilot regions.

- 6,550+ farmers
