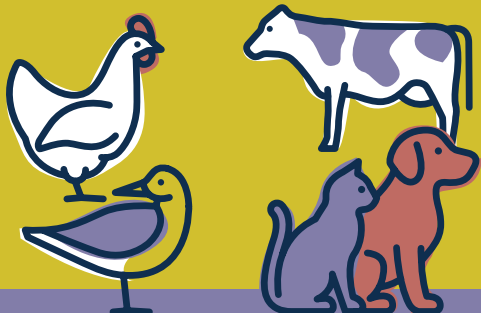
How H5 bird flu can impact our wildlife

H5 bird flu is the most serious type of bird flu. Early action helps reduce impacts on our wildlife and natural environments.

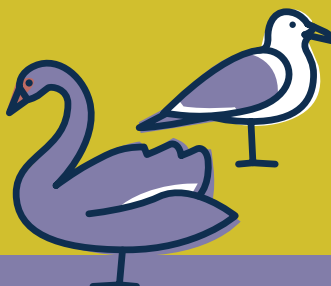


If H5 bird flu establishes in Australia

It can spread between birds and mammals.



It may impact birds we see all the time, like seagulls and swans.

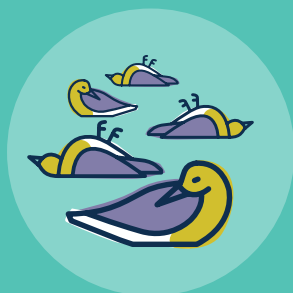


Some native species may be badly impacted, particularly if already threatened, like Tasmanian devils and quolls.



Some wildlife populations could **significantly decline**, affecting ecosystems and biodiversity.

Everyone can help



Report sick or dead wildlife.

Keep dogs on a leash and cats contained, especially near wildlife.



Don't touch or move dead birds or other wildlife.
