
## Australian Sea Lion

Scientific Name: Neophoca cinerea



Distribution: WA, SA, occasionally NSW, VIC, TAS

EPBC Act Status: Vulnerable and Marine

**Size:** Males: 2-2.5m; 250-300kg Females: 1.3-1.8m; 61-104kg

Colour: Male dark brown with mane-like yellow areas on neck and top of head. Female silver grey to fawn on back and creamy-coloured underneath. Juveniles chocolate brown with a pale fawn crown until moulting at two months to resemble colours of an adult female. **Key Features:** Stocky body, a large head, thick neck and short, narrow flippers. Small, external ears and one

layer of fur. Blunter, more rounded snout than fur seals.

## **Preferred Habitat:**

Sandy beaches and rocky coastline, often in sheltered areas and isolated bays, on offshore islands and the Australian mainland.
