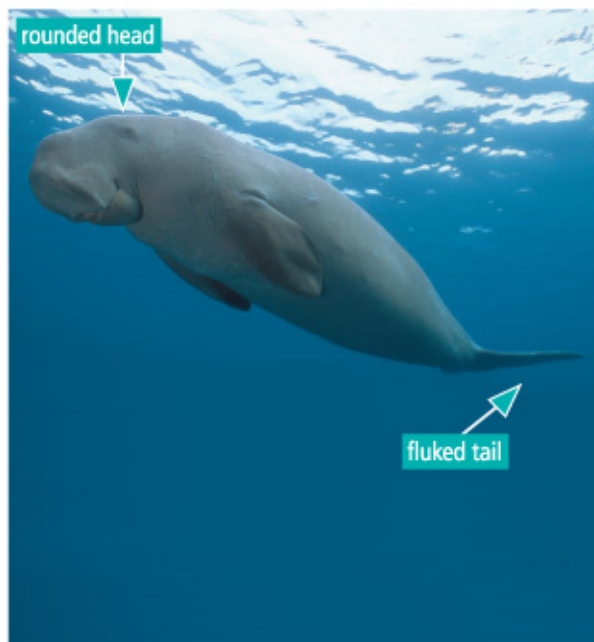


Dugong

Scientific Name: Dugong dugon

Distribution: NT, WA, QLD, occasionally NSW

EPBC Act Status: Migratory and Marine

Length: Up to 3m

Colour: Grey

Key Features: Rounded head, small eyes and a large snout. Sensitive bristles cover the upper lip of their large and fleshy snout.

Small tusks can be seen in adult males and some older females. Fluked tail.

Poor eyesight and sensitive hearing.

Habitat:

Seagrass meadows in shallow tropical waters.
