
## Hawksbill Turtle

Scientific Name: Eretmochelys imbricata



Distribution: QLD, NT, WA

EPBC Act Status: Vulnerable, Migratory and Marine

Length: Up to 80cm

**Colour:** Olive green or brown shell, extensively variegated with brown and black markings.

Underside yellow or white.

Key Features: Beak-like mouth and narrow head.

Thick overlapping scales on shell.

Four or more pairs of large costal scales. Males have a longer, thicker tail that extends beyond the shell. **Preferred Habitat:** 

Tidal and subtidal coral and rocky reefs in tropical and subtropical areas.
