I, TOM BLACK, Acting First Assistant Secretary, Delegate of the Secretary of the Department with responsibility for administering the *Export Control Act 2020* (Cth) (**Department**), acting under subsection 288(2) of the *Export Control Act 2020* (Cth) (**Act**):

1. **REVOKE** the instrument of subdelegation made by the First Assistant Secretary, Delegate of the Secretary of the Department, under subsection 288(2) of the Act, dated 18 January 2023; and
2. **SUBDELEGATE** the functions and powers set out in each cell in column 3 of Schedule 1 to each person from time to time occupying, or acting in, a position that is captured by the delegate level described in the corresponding cell in column 2 of Schedule 1. The exercise of these functions and powers is subject to any limitation described in the corresponding cell in column 4 of Schedule 1.

This instrument commences on 24 November 2023.

NOTICE OF INTERNAL REVIEW DECISION: VARIATION TO THE CONDITIONS OF REGISTRATION OF ESTABLISHMENT^{s 47G(1)(a)} UNDER SUBSECTION 123(1) OF THE EXPORT CONTROL ACT 2020 (CTH)

I refer to the application for internal review made by The Game Meats Company Pty Ltd (**GMC**) on 13 December 2024, which sought review of a decision by the Secretary's delegate dated 28 November 2024 to vary the conditions on the registration of Establishment^{s 47G(1)(a)} under s 123(1)(b) of the *Export Control Act 2020* (**Act**) (**reviewable decision**).

Under item 25 of s 381(1) of the Act, a decision to vary the condition of the registration of an establishment is a reviewable decision. Under s 383(3), on receiving an application, the Secretary must either:

- a) review the reviewable decision personally; or
- b) cause the reviewable decision to be reviewed by a person (the internal reviewer) who:
 - i) is a person to whom the Secretary's power to review the decision has been delegated; and
 - ii) was not involved in making the decision; and
 - iii) occupies a position senior to the person who actually made the decision.

Following the review, the Secretary or internal reviewer may:

- a) affirm, vary or set aside the reviewable decision; and
- b) if the Secretary or the internal reviewer sets aside the reviewable decision—make such other decision as the Secretary or the internal reviewer thinks appropriate.

I am the internal reviewer for the purpose of s 383 of the Act.

In accordance with s 383(6) of the Act, I am writing to advise you that I have decided to affirm the reviewable decision to vary the registration of Establishment^{s 47G(1)(a)}

My reasons for affirming the reviewable decision are set out at **Attachment A** to this notice.

Details of the variation

Under s 123(1)(b) of the Act, the registration of Establishment^{s 47G(1)(a)} is varied to impose the following new conditions:

	Conditions
1	The Game Meats Company must install, and monitor, a closed circuit television (CCTV) system:

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	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Operating at all critical control points within the Establishment where animal receipt, handling, stunning and slaughter occurs, when livestock is being processed for exports. 2. Operating at ingress points externally, and positioned in a way to improve site security. 3. That captures time and date stamped footage, and have a resolution that provides sufficient capacity to analyse footage effectively. <p>The Game Meats Company must have an appropriately qualified officer review this footage on a daily basis to ensure the requirements of the <i>Export Control Act 2020</i> (inclusive of AS4696:2023) are being complied with.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. CCTV footage is to be retained by the Game Meats Company for 12 months in a format that is accessible to the department and is to be provided to the department within 24 hours of request. ii. An observed failure to adhere to AS4696:2023 must be reported to the departmental on-plant veterinarian within 24 hours.
2	<p>A person in management and control of export operations carried out at the Establishment must provide a signed declaration on the last business day of each month to the department:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Confirming that the Game Meats Company is compliant with all animal welfare components of the Australian Meat Standard (AS4696:2023); and ii. Including details of all animal welfare incident reports raised, observed failures and the corrective actions undertaken to rectify these failures.
3	<p>The Game Meats Company must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Ensure that the restraint system and electrical stunning equipment is suitably designed and appropriate for the livestock that is being processed at the establishment. ii. Have a documented procedure for the monitoring of insensibility of livestock following stunning, with staff training associated with the monitoring procedure. iii. Ensure all staff handling livestock are provided training and routine refresher training in the safe and appropriate stock handling techniques, which must be provided by an external training provider. iv. Keep evidence of the training, re-training and certification of all operators on site and provide the information for review and audit by the department on request.
4	<p>The Game Meats Company must engage an independent animal welfare expert with experience in meat processing facilities (and as agreed to by the department) to undertake a comprehensive root cause analysis of the animal welfare practices at the Establishment.</p> <p>The analysis must take into consideration all animal welfare processes, systems and management controls and provide recommendations to ensure the establishment complies with the AS4696:2023.</p> <p>This review is to be completed within 6 months, with the full report, including the recommendations, provided to both the Game Meats Company and the department.</p>

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Fisheries and Forestry

5	<p>The Game Meats Company must have an Australian Government Authorised Officer (AAO) present at all times during the hours of production to perform regulatory meat inspection activities, including post-mortem duties.</p> <p>Note: In accordance with the Australian Export Meat Inspection System (AEMIS), an AAO provides post-mortem inspection and final disposition on all carcasses and carcase parts under department veterinary (OPV) supervision.</p>
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This variation takes effect on **17 March 2025**.

Right to merits review

Under s 385 of the Act, the occupier of the registered establishment has the right to apply to the Administrative Review Tribunal (**Tribunal**) for review of an internal review decision made under s 383 that relates to a reviewable decision.

An application to the Tribunal may be made within 28 days after the applicant is given the statement of reasons for the decision.

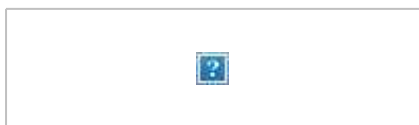
