Report to the Parliament in relation to the Funding Agreement 2017–21 with Australian Livestock Export Corporation Limited (LiveCorp) for 2018–19

- I, Senator the Honorable Bridget McKenzie, Minister for Agriculture, under section 68C of the Australian Meat and Live-stock Industry Act 1997 (Act), report that:
 - a. the Commonwealth had a funding agreement with Australian Livestock Export Corporation Limited (LiveCorp) in force for 2018–19;
 - b. the statutory levies paid by the Commonwealth to LiveCorp under subsections 64A(1) and 64B(1) of the Act, as reported in the LiveCorp audited financial statements, totalled \$4,545,008 for 2018–19; and
 - c. on the basis of the information provided by LiveCorp in the Schedule, I am satisfied that the spending by LiveCorp of statutory levies during 2018–19 complied, in all material respects, with the Funding Agreement 2017–21 between the Commonwealth and LiveCorp.

SCHEDULE

Australian Livestock Export Corporation Limited (LiveCorp) has provided assurances that its spending of the statutory levies paid by the Commonwealth to LiveCorp, under subsections 64A(1) and 64B(1) of the *Australian Meat and Live-stock Industry Act 1997*, during 2018–19 complied with the Funding Agreement 2017–21 (the agreement) between the Commonwealth and LiveCorp:

- a. an independent audit of the 2018–19 financial statements, providing an opinion that the financial statements reflect a true and fair view of LiveCorp's financial position as at 30 June 2019 and of its performance for the year ended on that date;
- b. an independent compliance audit report, expressing the opinion that LiveCorp complied with its obligations under clauses 25 and 26 of the agreement (the management and application of funds clauses) in 2018–19;and
- c. a statement from the Chair and Chief Executive Officer certifying that LiveCorp has complied with the agreement in 2018–19.
