

The Australian Government is supporting Tyre Stewardship Australia to recycle used mining, agriculture and aviation tyres, rubber tracks and conveyor belts.

## The problem

Each year, over 120,000 tonnes of mining, agriculture and aviation tyres reach end of life, with only 11% being recovered. It's estimated an additional 80,000 tonnes of related products are not being sustainably managed each year.

## The solution

Tyre Stewardship Australia's project will provide a national framework for increased recycling of mining, agriculture and aviation tyres, rubber tracks and conveyor belts.

The Australian Government is providing a grant of \$987,717 for the project through the National Product Stewardship Investment Fund.

## When

Tyre Stewardship Australia's project will commence from August 2021.
