


## Australian pig meat industry



## **AUSTRALIAN CONSUMPTION**



Australia consumed approximately

28kg of pig meat/person in 2019–20,
ranked 2nd only behind poultry meat

## **PRODUCTION AND TRADE**



The gross value of Australian pig meat production was **\$1.5 billion in 2019–20**, 25% higher than the previous year



Australia produced
403,000 tonnes of pig meat
in 2018–19 (carcass weight)



Queensland was the largest producing state, accounting for 24% of the total



Over the last five years, annual exports have averaged **approximately 30,000 tonnes** (shipped weight) with Singapore the largest market in terms of volume and value



The total value of Australian pig meat exports in 2019–20 was \$139 million – up 18% on the previous year



Over the hooks price for Australian pigs rose by 29% in 2019–20 to an average 377 cents/kg (carcase weight)
