



Australian pig meat industry



AUSTRALIAN CONSUMPTION



Australia consumed approximately **28kg of pig meat/person in 2019–20**, ranked 2nd only behind poultry meat

PRODUCTION AND TRADE



The gross value of Australian pig meat production was **\$1.5 billion in 2019–20**, 25% higher than the previous year



Australia produced **403,000 tonnes of pig meat** in 2018–19 (carcass weight)



Queensland was the largest producing state, **accounting for 24% of the total**



Over the last five years, annual exports have averaged **approximately 30,000 tonnes (shipped weight)** with Singapore the largest market in terms of volume and value



The total value of Australian pig meat exports in 2019–20 was **\$139 million – up 18% on the previous year**



Over the hooks price for Australian pigs rose by **29% in 2019–20 to an average 377 cents/kg (carcase weight)**
