If an authorised officer records a consignment of plants or plant products as failed on this record, the client must advise an authorised officer if the goods are being resubmitted and must have complied with the additional requirements set out in section 9-11 of the Plant Rules 2021. This record is the approved record for an assessment of goods under section 9-14 of the Plant Rules 2021 and must be accompanied by a Bulk Vessel Loading Running Record.
