The report provides information on donations made to environmental organisations to benefit the natural environment



For the decade (2009–2018)



was collected in donations.



Total donations to organisations on the REO has increased.



A small number of organisations collect the majority of donations.



Donors are becoming more generous—number of donations over the decade has declined whilst total donations has increased.

Increasingly organisations are focused on *climate change* and **energy** related issues.

\$184 million in donations has been

reported so far for 2018

10% of organisations collected around 80% of total donations.



Registered organisations reported spending around \$181 million

on preserving the natural environment in 2018. \$152 million of this

was used in Australia.



Donations made are predominately monetary with a small proportion gifting property.

\$4.3 million in property donations so far for 2018.
