Outputs

While there may be outputs specific to individual Threatened Ecological Communities, example outputs

• Number of hectares where condition has improved.

• Number of hectares weed/pest control-initial and follow up.

• Number of pest animals killed.

• Number of hydrological barriers

• Ad hoc outputs related to site

Rationale

Listing and Conservation Advices provide the basis for directly measuring the improvement in the condition of sites, based on the transition from one condition class to another, or by the removal of threats indicative of poor condition. This suite of outputs reflects those actions. These outputs can be used as indicators of progress in order to facilitate milestone payments and gauge
