
First Nations Commitment

- Statement of Strategic Intent
- Reflects First Nations peoples' aspirations
- Pursuit of First Nations economic self-determination
- First Nations agribusiness barriers and contributions

1.8% of total workforce

40% employed in sheep, beef cattle and grain farming

0.6% of business owners



First Nations opportunities

- Economic benefit from First Nations businesses
- \$1 earned = \$4.41 in social and economic value




Reporting the Indigenous estate

"Land or forest over which Indigenous peoples and communities have ownership, management, or rights of use for customary purposes."










The Indigenous estate covers most of Australia


70% of Australia is in the Indigenous land estate
