- 4. SHOT FEMALES MUST BE EXAMINED FOR POUCH YOUNG AND IF ONE IS PRESENT IT MUST BE KILLED IMMEDIATELY BY DECAPITATION OR BY A HEAVY BLOW TO THE SKULL TO DESTROY THE BRAIN, OR BY SHOOTING.
- 5. THE LANDOWNER MUST INDICATE THE TOTAL NUMBER OF ALL POSSUMS TAKEN AND RETURN HIS PERMITS TO THE DIRECTOR. THE LANDOWNER MAY REQUEST A RENEWAL IN THE SPACE PROVIDED, AND REQUEST RENEWAL OF AGENT PERMITS BY PROVIDING A LIST OF NAMES AND ADDRESSES.
