This permit authorises the above person to take by
SHOOTING WITH THE AID OF A VEHICLE AND SPOTLIGHT DURING PROHIBITED
HOURS >>NON COMMERCIAL<<

Brush Possum

on the properties listed below and subject to the following
conditions:

1. THIS PERMIT MUST BE CARRIED WHILE TAKING WILDLIFE AND PRODUCED ON DEMAND BY AN AUTHORISED OFFICER.
2. THE SALE OF SKINS OF BRUSH POSSUM TAKEN UNDER THIS PERMIT IS PROHIBITED.
3. ALL CARCASSES INCLUDING SKINS MUST BE BURIED OR BURNT ON THE PROPERTY OR UTILISED BY THE PERMIT HOLDER.
4. SHOT FEMALES MUST BE EXAMINED FOR POUCH YOUNG AND IF ONE IS PRESENT IT MUST BE KILLED IMMEDIATELY BY DECAPITATION OR BY A HEAVY BLOW TO THE SKULL TO DESTROY THE BRAIN, OR BY SHOOTING.
5. THE LANDOWNER MUST INDICATE THE TOTAL NUMBER OF ALL POSSUMS TAKEN AND RETURN HIS PERMITS TO THE DIRECTOR. THE LANDOWNER MAY REQUEST A RENEWAL IN THE SPACE PROVIDED, AND REQUEST RENEWAL OF AGENT PERMITS BY PROVIDING A LIST OF NAMES AND ADDRESSES.
