- (a) for a period of 28 days commencing the day this Order is made; or
- (b) if this order has been extended, until the end of the extended period; or
- (c) until the time when this Order is revoked.

Section C: The circumstances under which this Order will be revoked

This Order remains in force until the Secretary (or delegate) revokes it. This Order will immediately be revoked under these circumstances:

Republic of Korea authorities provide assurances that appropriate corrective actions have been implemented to ensure future imports are safe.
