
The Water Act 2007 allows the Commonwealth Environmental Water Holder to sell water allocations if at least one of two conditions is met:

TRADE Environmental watering objectives have been met and either: the water cannot be carried **OPTION 1** over; or keeping the allocations is likely to result in future allocations being reduced.

Are water allocations required to meet environmental objectives during the water year?







Trade is an option.

Environmental outcomes can be improved by selling water allocations and using the TRADE **OPTION 2** proceeds to purchase water and/or invest in environmental activities.
