Bovine	Bovine spongiform encephalopathy agent (protease resistant prion protein PrP ^{Sc})	Bovine spongiform encephalopathy (BSE)
Camel	Camel prion disease agent (protease resistant prion protein PrP ^{Sc})	Camel prion disease (CPD)
Cervids (including deer, elk and moose)	Chronic wasting disease agent (protease resistant prion protein PrP ^{Sc})	Chronic wasting disease agent (CWD)
Mink	Transmissible mink encephalopathy agent (protease resistant prion protein PrP ^{Sc})	Transmissible mink encephalopathy (TME)
Ovine	Scrapie agent (protease resistant prion protein PrP ^{Sc})	Scrapie
Species – other (as determined by the department on application)	Other agents of transmissible spongiform encephalopathies as determined by the department based on origin and end use	Other transmissible spongiform encephalopathies
