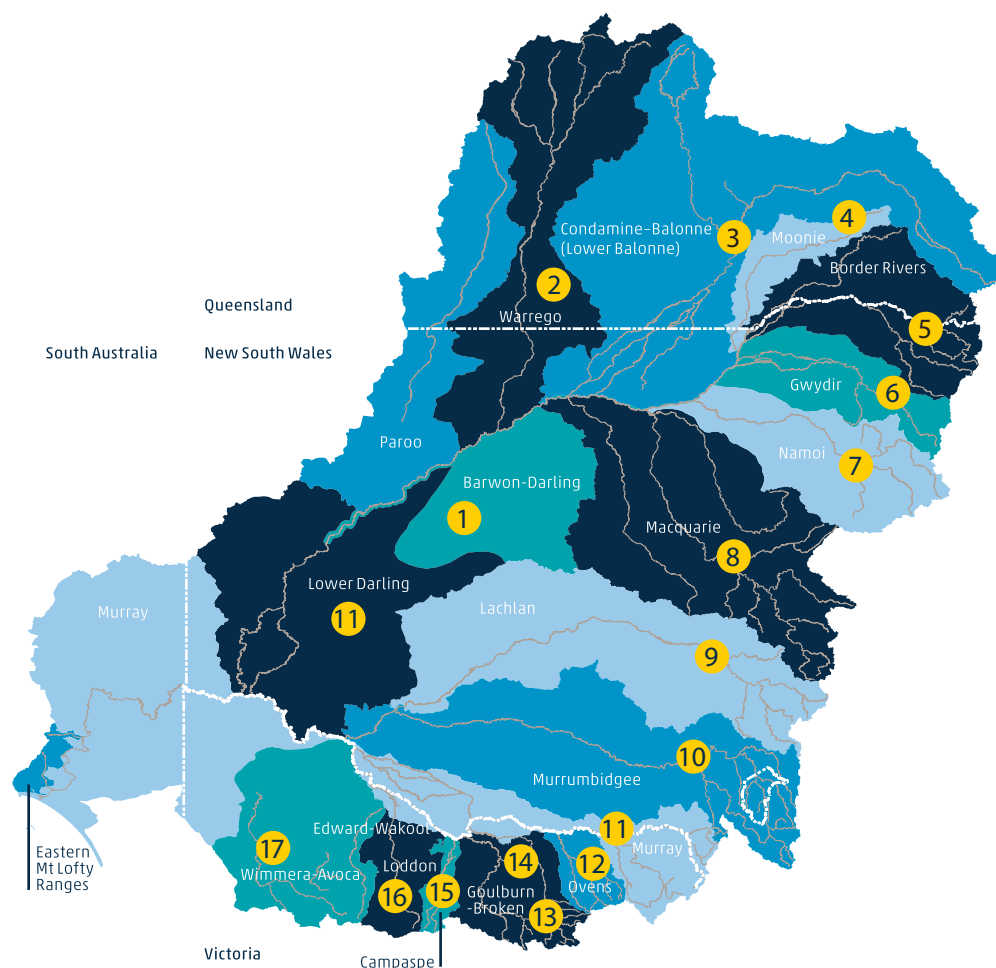


Commonwealth environmental water use in Basin catchments (as at 30 April 2022)
