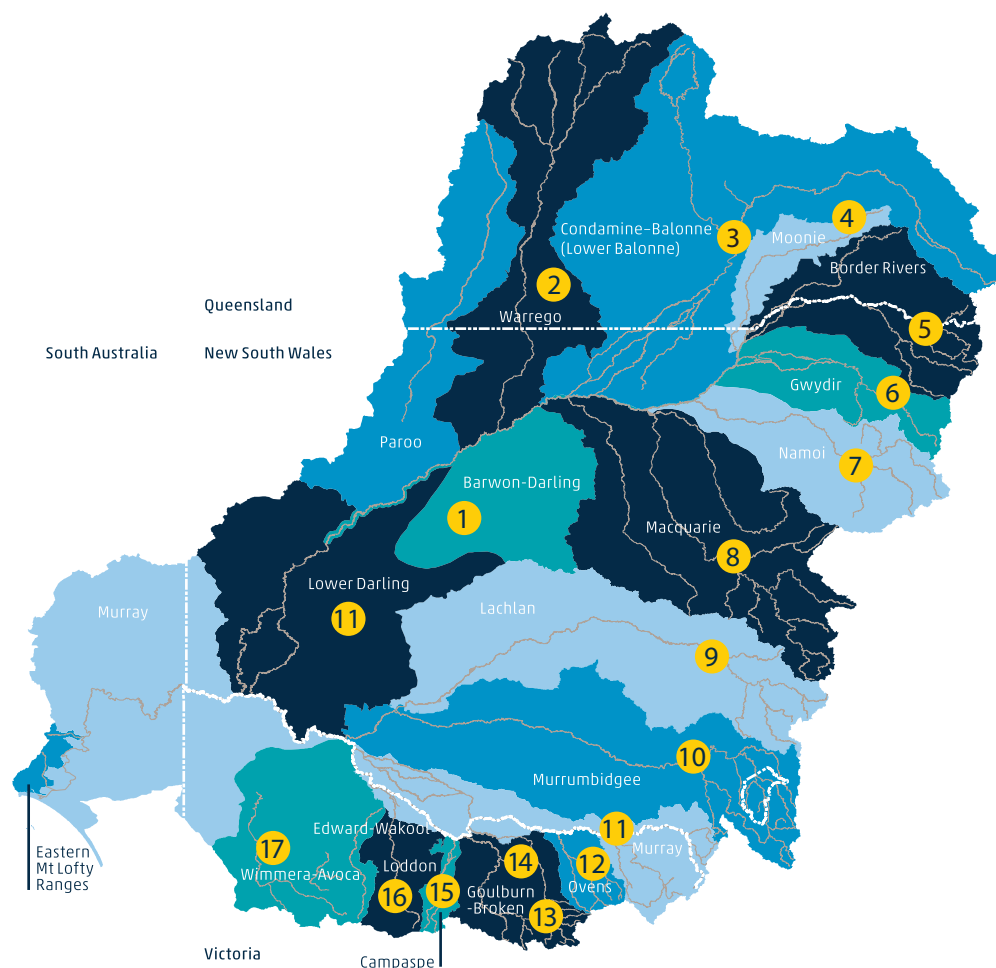


# Commonwealth environmental water use in Basin catchments (as at 31 October 2021)
