

Commonwealth environmental water use in Basin catchments (as at 30 September 2021)

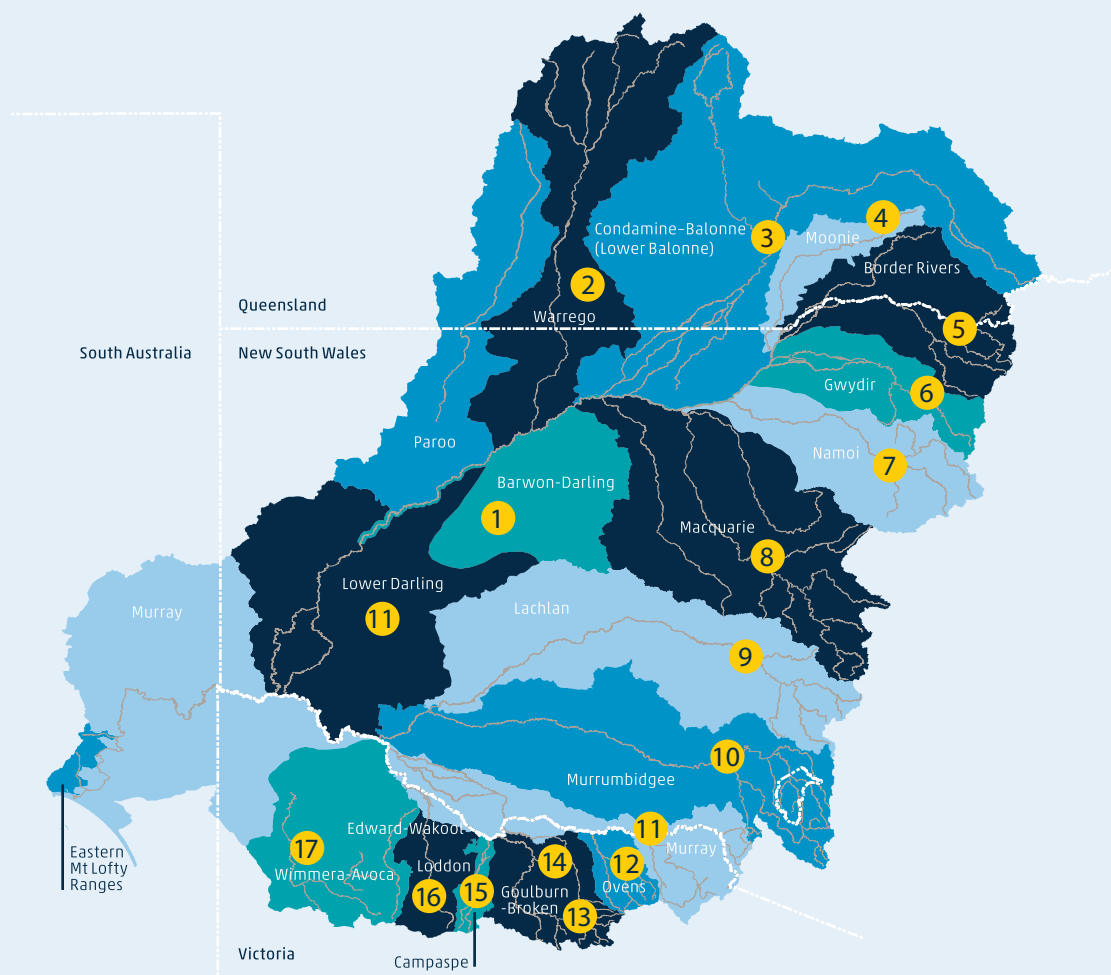
