Wool Annual Return

Before lodging	To be eligible for lodging annual return and payment, you must have reasonable grounds to believe that the total amount of wool which you are likely to deal in, in a financial year, amounts to less than \$500 of levy. You must also make an application to the Secretary of the Department of Agriculture, Water and the Environment. If you would like to make an application please contact the department's Levies Office in your state or territory. See agriculture.gov.au/ag-farm-food/levies/rates/wool for details.

Due date	Return and payment must be lodged with the department within 28 days of the end of the financial year in which the transaction took place. Example: for the 2019-2020 financial year ended 30 June 2020, the return and payment are due to the department on or before 28 August 2020.
Late payments	Late levy payments will incur a penalty that is calculated daily at a compounding rate of 2 per cent each month, including any penalties you have already accrued, until you have paid the outstanding return amount in full.

SECTION F: Privacy notice

'Personal information' means any information or opinion about an identified or reasonably identifiable individual.

The collection of mandatory information as denoted by an asterisk (*) is authorised by the *Primary Industries Levies and Charges Collection Act 1991* (the Act) and the Primary Industries Levies and Charges Collection Regulations 1991 for the purpose of administering the wool levy and charge. If you do not provide the mandatory information requested in this form, you will be in breach of the Act and the Department of Agriculture, Water and the Environment may be required to take action. The personal information collected may include information in relation to your business, including your ABN, business name, contact person details, email address, physical address and phone number.

The department may disclose your personal information to levy recipient organisations and the Australian Bureau of Statistics where necessary for the above purposes, provided the disclosure is consistent with relevant laws, in particular the *Primary Industries Levies and Charges Collection Act 1991* and the *Privacy Act 1988* (Privacy Act).

Your personal information will be used and stored in accordance with the Australian Privacy Principles. SECTION G: Definitions

Sale value means the price or amount paid for the wool net GST, handling, storage, and transport costs.
