Implementation Checklist

The implementation checklist is designed to aid users implementation of electronic certification. It consists of a tracking line and associated steps for implementation.

Implementation Tracking Line

Is a tracking system to allow users to map out and measure progress.

Implementation steps

This maps the individual steps. These steps are numbered and fall into two categories; implementation documents and system functionality. The steps can be checked off on the implementation tracking line as completed.

System Steps

Two: Consider the impact on your current system/s. Complete self-assessment guide.

Three: Review impact on clearance activities

Four: Determine type of trial
 a) Concept (view system to system)
 b) Pull (extract data from website)
 c) Push (data pushed to your system)

Five: Consider the Terms of Reference (review ToR)
 a) Who needs access
 b) Duration of trial
 c) Management outcomes

Six: Check current activities and organise participants

Eight: Commence trial

Nine: Complete scheduled trial reports

Ten: Agree all issues are addressed and future work.

Thirteen: Consider next steps to implement
