I understand that should one sample from a batch test positive for WSSV/YHV, that batch will be declared positive and directed to be exported or destroyed. Requests to treat product (e.g. cook) will be considered on a case-by-case basis. If I request retesting of positive samples, I understand the samples will be sent to the Australian Animal Health Laboratory (AAHL) and all costs associated will be borne by the importer/PIC.

I understand that I must inform the Department of Agriculture and Water Resources of the test results by producing a copy of the laboratory results report before the release of the consignment can be considered.

I agree to allow the laboratory to disclose details of the test results, country of origin and consignment details to the Australian Department of Agriculture and Water Resources.
