## PLANT BIOSECURITY POLICY MEMORANDUM 2001/07

## FRESH LONGANS AND LYCHEES FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA

This Plant Biosecurity Policy Memorandum (PBPM) provides stakeholders with the minutes from the stakeholder meetings held in Brisbane and Mareeba in January 2001 on the progress of the Import Risk Analysis (IRA) on the importation of longans and lychees from the People's Republic of China.

PBPM 2000/26 of 20 December 2000, advised all stakeholders that as part of the consultative process, public meetings with stakeholders would be held in Brisbane and Mareeba on 29 and 31 January 2001, respectively, to discuss the preliminary pest lists and identify potential quarantine pests of fresh fruits of longan and lychee.

For those stakeholders who were unable to attend, the minutes of the two stakeholder meetings including points of discussion are enclosed for your information. All stakeholders will be notified of the date and venues of future stakeholder meetings as the IRA progresses.
