## PLANT BIOSECURITY POLICY MEMORANDUM 2003/32 FINAL IMPORT POLICY FOR NETHERLANDS TRUSS TOMATOES

This Plant Biosecurity Policy Memorandum (PBPM) is to notify stakeholders of the release of final import policy for truss tomatoes from the Netherlands.

PBPM 2003/13 of 24 March 2003 notified stakeholders of the release of the draft import policy for truss tomatoes from the Netherlands. Biosecurity Australia received comments from several stakeholders. These comments have been considered and where appropriate incorporated into the import policy.

This import policy permits the entry of truss tomatoes into Australia from the Netherlands under the conditions outlined within the import policy document.
