PLANT BIOSECURITY POLICY MEMORANDUM 2003/33

DRAFT IMPORT POLICY FOR FRESH PERSIMMON FRUIT FROM JAPAN, KOREA AND ISRAEL

This Plant Biosecurity Policy Memorandum is to notify stakeholders of the release of the draft import policy report for fresh persimmon fruit from Japan, Korea and Israel, considered as an extension under the existing policy for fresh persimmon fruit from New Zealand and US.

Plant Biosecurity Policy Memorandum 2003/16 of 18 June 2003 notified stakeholders of Plant Biosecurity's intention to assess the market access requests for persimmons from Japan, Korea and Israel as an extension of existing policy.

A *draft import policy for persimmon fruit from Japan, Korea and Israel* has now been developed. The draft import policy is available from the DAFF website at <u>www.daff.gov.au/plantbiosecurity</u> or copies can be requested from Technical and Administrative Services. Comments on the draft import policy should be received by Technical and Administrative Services by 31 January 2004.
