

# Application for ballast water exemptions

Form approved under Chapter 5 of the Biosecurity Act 2015

# Section A: General information

# Purpose of this form

For ship owners to apply for exemptions from the requirement to:

- obtain an approved ballast water management plan
- obtain an approved ballast water management certificate
- meet the Regulation D-2 discharge standard of the International Convention for the Control and Management of Ships' Ballast Water and Sediments (Ballast Water Management Convention).

### Eligibility

Vessels operating internationally are not eligible for these exemptions.

Domestic vessels operating solely in the Australian Exclusive Economic Zone and on the high seas are eligible for exemptions.

Vessels operating predominantly in the Australian Exclusive Economic Zone and that only travel outside the zone for dry docking may be eligible for exemption from the requirement to meet the Regulation D-2 discharge standard.

See <u>Guidelines for ballast water management equivalent compliance (G3)</u> for exemptions under Regulation A-5 of the Ballast Water Management Convention for recreational or search and rescue vessels less than 50 metres long with 8 cubic metres of ballast.

## 8 Exemption from requirement to obtain an approved ballast water management plan.

You do not need to apply if your vessel:

- has sealed tanks that only discharge for the purpose of scheduled maintenance, dry-docking or emergency
- is recreational and weighs less than 400 gross tonnes.

To apply for an exemption, explain why a ballast water management plan is not applicable or cannot be obtained.

For example, the vessel uses potable water and only discharges for scheduled maintenance, dry-docking or emergency or is a dumb barge that has no power source to pump water.

### 9 Exemption from requirement to obtain an approved ballast water management certificate.

You do not need to apply if your vessel is recreational and weighs less than 400 gross tonnes.

# 10 Exemption from requirement to meet Regulation D-2 discharge standard of the Ballast Water Management Convention.

You do not need to apply if your vessel:

- uses only potable water solely in Australian waters
- is a dumb barge with no power source
- only discharges ballast water taken up in the same place (port limits or within 1 nautical mile of the uptake location)
- weighs less than 400 gross tonnes and is not required to obtain an International Oil Pollution Prevention Certificate. These vessels will not need to meet the D-2 discharge standard until 2024.
