USA: High Security seals for Containers

The United States (US) Customs and Border Protection (CBP) has issued a notice to shippers and importers stating that all loaded maritime containers arriving by vessel at a port of entry in the US on or after 15 October 2008, are required to use a seal meeting the ISO PAS 17712 Standard. CBP have advised that they will phase in the enforcement of the new seal requirements. Once fully enforced, containers sealed incorrectly may be refused entry and returned. Specific time frames for the phase-in period have not been supplied and industry is encouraged to implement these requirements as soon as possible.

AQIS seals issued since 29 January 2008 meet the ISO PAS 17712 standard test requirements. Exporters using company seals are advised to liaise with their seal supplier/manufacturer to ensure that the seals they apply meet the relevant standard.
