## 6. PRIVACY POLICY

'Personal information' means any information or opinion about an identified, or reasonably identifiable, individual.

The Department of Agriculture and Water Resources may disclose your personal information to relevant authorities in an importing country and other Australian agencies, such as the Australian Maritime Safety Authority provided the disclosure is consistent with the *Privacy Act 1988* and other relevant laws. Your personal information may also be disclosed to relevant employees within your organisation for the purpose of approving your licence, registration or accreditation and to maintain the currency of your personal information for the purpose of the licence, registration or accreditation. Your personal information will be used and stored in accordance with the Australian Privacy Principles.

By completing and submitting this form you consent to the collection, use and disclosure of all personal information, including sensitive information, in this form to and by the relevant authorities in the importing country and other Australian agencies.
