



While pre-export inspection of livestock and verification of core documentation will continue to be required for all consignments, changes will include:

- shortened processes for a Notice of Intention for export (NOI)
- no need for a separate Consignment Risk Management Plan (CRMP) to be approved for each export
- no need for an Approved Export Plan (AEP) or Permission to Leave for Loading (PLL)

Commencement of Approved Arrangements

The department is implementing Approved Arrangements, including trialling the new system with a number of exporters. Approved arrangements will be available to exporters from April 2016 and all exporters will need an Approved Arrangement to export from 1 January 2017.

Exemptions

Exporters may apply to be considered as a small and infrequent exporter. This exempts the exporter from Approved Arrangements and reduced fees apply.
