1. To apply for a licence to export meat – the fresh or preserved flesh of calves, cattle, goats, lambs, sheep, meat products, meat by-products and edible offal.
 2. To renew a meat export licence.
 3. To notify of a change in name of an existing licensee.
 4. To notify of a change in management or control.

a completed [credit card/cheque payment form](#) for the annual meat export licence charge. Please see the department’s [charging guidelines](#) for the amount payable. Make cheques payable to Collector of Public Monies, Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry.

You do not need to pay the charge if you are an occupier of a registered establishment under the *Export Control Act 2020* or to notify of a change in name or change in management or control.




