INDUSTRY ADVICE NOTICE NO. 2012/31

Plant Export Operations Manual and Work Instruction for Hay and Straw

Purpose

To advise industry of new procedural resources for sampling, inspection and certification of hay and straw for export are now accessible on the Plant Export Operations Manual (PEOM) website.

Background

The Export Control (Hay and Straw) Orders 2005 where repealed in 2011 and the provisions within these Orders were incorporated within the Export Control (Plants and Plant Products) Order 2011.

The Plant Export Operations Manual (PEOM) and Work Instruction for the export of hay and straw have now been realigned with the current Order, providing procedural references for the sampling, inspection and certification of export hay and straw across Australia. This is to assist in achieving national consistency in export certification processes to meet importing country requirements and Australian plant export legislative requirements. Both the PEOM and Work Instructions should be read in conjunction with the Export Control (Plants and Plant Products) Order 2011.

Key points

- 1. The following procedural resources will come into effect on 6 August 2012:
 - PEOM Volume 8A Commodity inspections Hay & straw (http://www.daff.gov.au/aqis/export/plants-plant-products/plantexportsmanual)
 - Work Instruction HAS3001 Inspection and certification of hay and straw (http://www.daff.gov.au/aqis/export/plants-plant-products/plantexportsmanual/resources#a4)
- 2. From 6 August 2012 authorised officer candidates will be assessed against the above resources.

Exporter's responsibilities

- 1. Exporters of hay should familiarise themselves with PEOM Volume 8A Commodity inspections Hay & straw and work instruction HAS3001 Inspection and certification of hay and straw prior to presenting hay and straw for export
- Exporters should refer to the Manual of Importing Country Requirements (<u>www.daff.gov.au/micor/plants</u>) prior to exporting hay or straw to ensure import conditions can be complied with.

Authorised Officer Responsibilities

1. Authorised Officers are to ensure they are familiar and comply with PEOM Volume 8A Commodity inspections – Hay & straw and work instruction HAS3001 Inspection and certification of hay and straw prior to inspecting hay and straw for export.
