## Purpose of this form

For approved arrangement managers of class 19 approved arrangements to apply to:

- vary the approved arrangement manager for a class 19 approved arrangement
- add or remove class 19.2 Automatic entry processing for commodities (AEPCOMM) to the approved arrangement.
